NETWORKING

Grama Vikas (GV) believes that that a strong network among NGOs will have a lot of bearing on the mindset of Policy makers to design PRO-POOR policies. Network of NGOs will have the following advantages:

- Horizontal learnings
- Resources can be shared among the NGOs
- Can design COMMON PROGRAMMES to create greater impact on the mindset of the bureaucracy
- Can lead networking of primary stake-holders as well
